Black Eyed Peas to Perform at 20th Annual BayFest

MCB Hawaii – June 23, 2009 – BayFest, Oahu’s premier summer family festival, celebrates 20 years of musical magic, August 14-16 at Marine Corps Base Hawaii, with the announcement of their biggest headline act to-date - The Black Eyed Peas. The band performs live on the JN Automotive Main Stage, Saturday, August 15, at 8:30 p.m.

The Black Eyed Peas have transcended their hip-hop roots and become a global phenomenon. The Grammy-winning quartet comprised of will.i.am, Fergie, apl.de.ap and Taboo has released five studio albums featuring such hits as “Let’s Get It Started” and “Don’t Phunk with My Heart.” Their June 9, 2009 release, The E.N.D. features “Boom Boom Pow,” the group’s first song to reach number one on the Billboard Hot 100.

Tickets go on sale through Ticketmaster and www.bayfesthawaii.com on June 27 and are expected to sell out. Tickets purchased in advance are \$45 and the gate price will increase to \$55.

With Grucci fireworks, EK Fernandez carnival rides, contests and entertainment, BayFest is Oahu’s premier summer family festival. General grounds admission is \$5; children five years and under are free. Gates open at 5 p.m. on August 14 and noon on August 15-16.

BayFest is open to the general public and organized by Marine Corps Community Services (MCCS), a Department of Defense quality of life program that supports the morale, welfare and recreation of Hawaii’s Marines, Sailors, and their families.
