Tickets are available now online at BayFestHawaii.com and May 2 at all military ticket outlets for authorized patrons.

A general admission ticket provides access to the E.K. Fernandez carnival and midway, GreenFest @ BayFest Expo, fireworks, competitions, food and military displays. A new ticket is required for entry each day of BayFest. Concert tickets for each evening include general admission. Admission is free for children five and under.
